

Sports Premium Funding 2016 - 2017

Primary PE and Sport Premium is an initiative that aims to help increase and improve the PE and sporting opportunities for children. It was first provided in the 2013/14 academic year and the current government has pledged to continue this funding until 2020. It is jointly funded by the Department for Education, the Department for Health and Culture and the Department for Media and Sport. It has been allocated to schools and is ring-fenced, meaning that it can only be spent on the provision of PE and sport in schools.

Support funded through Sport Premium allocation

This year we have used our Sports Premium funding to continue to develop competitive sport within the school and develop staff training across many areas of PE. We have continued to update and develop equipment for children to use across the curriculum and during lunch times.

Our range of PE equipment was enhanced with the purchase of whistles, skipping ropes, dodge balls, bean bags, tennis balls, and tennis rackets.

A School Football team for years 5 and 6 has been running all year and a Friday workshop for every week for a year Lower school. The children have thoroughly enjoyed these and have entered into Cup and League games against other schools within the local area.

Impact of Sports premium funding

Rushmoor Schools Plus

- This was the second time that we had entered the Futsal tournament and we were placed 3rd out of 12 schools. At the Indoor Athletics festival we were placed 7th out of 12 schools. We are very proud of their achievements.
- All staff report increased confidence after their training in key areas and are using their renewed skills to enhance PE lessons further and to help other members of staff.
- Sports leaders have helped with the games at lunchtimes and have supported key areas of sporting events within the school year – Sports Relief mile, Sports day and helping to run the Sports Personality of the year voting.
- A consortium meeting every term allows the school to find information out and organise sporting activities and events.

PE Equipment

A renewal of particular equipment on a rolling programme of equipment that is replaced and others as an annual replacement due to wear and tear and general losses.

Sports leaders £180

Green hoodies bought for the children to wear so that they can be seen by all children and recognised when completing activities.

Sports Clubs

Over 150 children have attended the Lower School Friday workshop in the last year and have enjoyed the extra specialist Football coaching. The school Football team have played in Cup and League games against other schools within the local area and we are proud of their achievements.

League Fees £20.00

The team have entered the league for the first time in 2 years and have had many successful games. The team have shown good competitive spirit, teamwork and sportsmanship.

Football kit

The kit was bought as a replacement to our older kit and was made with the school logo embroidered onto it and in the school colours. This is used when playing against other schools. The children are very pleased with their new kit and wear it with pride.
